Proposal	Oak (T6) - We are seeking to remove this tree. As part of some building work undertaken at our property we had an Arboricultural Assessment made (now 3 yrs ago). This highlighted that this tree was in advanced stages of decline. This past winter especially we have had some significant breakway of smaller and medium sized branches falling down. We feel that it is becoming a danger for both house and people. A larger branch even broke away and fell onto our fence and over into our neighbours driveway during one of the bigger storms. We have serious concerns for this tree and feel that to avoid any further concern and damage it would be in everybodys interest to remove this tree.
